

DUTIES OF THE HOST OF THE YOUTH FEDERATION TOURNAMENT

1. THE HOST OF THE TOURNAMENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING ALL TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANTS WITH RESPECT TO THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE HOTELS. PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO BOOK ROOMS FOR THEMSELVES DIRECTLY AND FOR THEIR TEAMS. THEY ARE TO TAKE FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DISTURBANCE OR MATERIAL DAMAGE.
2. THE HOST OF THE TOURNAMENT MUST HAVE WRITTEN APPROVAL OR CONSENT FROM THE SOCCER LEAGUE/DISTRICT/ASSOCIATION TO WHICH IT BELONGS.
3. TOURNAMENT HOST MUST SUBMIT ALL WRITTEN CONSENT AND FORMS BY THE SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING OF THE FEDERATION, AS WELL AS SHOW ALL THE PREMISES WHERE THE TOURNAMENT SHALL TAKE PLACE. IF THIS CONDITION IS NOT FULFILLED, THE TOURNAMENT SHALL BE AWARDED TO THE NEXT CLUB ON THE LIST.
4. HOST MUST PROVIDE 4 FLAGS (USA, CANADA, NEW, AND OLD CROATIAN FLAGS). AS WELL AS A PROPER P.A. SYSTEM WITH SUFFICIENT POWER FOR THE MAJORITY OF THE FACILITY TO HEAR, AS WELL AS ALL 3 NATIONAL ANTHEMS.
5. HOST MUST ENSURE INSURANCE, AMBULANCE, OR PARAMEDICS FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT AND UP TO 30 MINUTES AFTER THE LAST GAME PLAYED OF EACH DAY.
6. HOST MUST PROVIDE A REPORT ON THE BUSINESS OF THE TOURNAMENT AT THE AGM TO ALL FEDERATION MEMBERS.
7. HOST MUST PROVIDE FIELD MARSHALL/DELEGATE. EACH ONE SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A COMMUNICATION DEVICE TO BE IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH MEDICS, ORGANIZERS, AND SAVEZ MEMBERS.
8. HOST CLUB TO HAVE AMPLE HOTEL ROOMS BLOCKED OFF FOR PARTICIPANTS. USUALLY, 8 ROOMS PER TEAM IS SUFFICIENT, THEREFOR 70 TEAMS A MINIMUM OF 560 ROOMS IS NEEDED.
9. HOST TO DIVIDE PLAYING FIELDS WHERE PLAYERS AND COACHES ARE OPPOSITE OF SPECTATORS AND PARENTS. A DRAWN MAP GIVEN TO SAVEZ FOR APPROVAL. DRAWINGS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR CLUBS TO RECEIVE AT REGISTRATION AND PROPERLY MARKED ON FIELDS FOR SAFETY REASONS.
10. HOST TO HAVE AMPLE ICE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE, DUE TO UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES.
11. HOST TO HAVE FULL TOURNAMENT PACKAGE WITH LOCAL ASSOCIATION RULES AND GUIDELINES REQUIRED FOR TOURNAMENT PLAY AT SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING.
12. TOURNAMENT DURATION IS REQUIRED TO BE 2 DAYS. ADMISSION FEE FOR NON-PLAYERS AND COACHES WILL BE NO MORE THAN \$5 PER PERSON PER DAY
13. HOST CLUB IS ALLOWED TO INVITE A NON-CROATIAN GUEST TEAM FROM THEIR LOCAL DISTRICT/ASSOCIATION, THIS IS ALLOWED ONLY IF THERE ARE 3 OR FEWER TEAMS IN ANY AGE GROUP. ALSO, AGE GROUPS MAY BE COMBINED TO ACCOMMODATE FOR LACK OF TEAMS IN AN AGE GROUP UPON APPROVAL FROM THE HNNS GOVERNING BOARD.
14. HOST MUST CONTACT ANY CLUB MINIMUM OF 10 DAYS BEFORE THE TOURNAMENT IF THAT AGE GROUP IS TO BE FOLDED OR IS CANCELLED.
15. PARTICIPANT MEDALS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL PLAYERS. CHAMPION AND RUNNER UP TEAM TROPHY IS REQUIRED FOR ALL AGE GROUPS.
16. ALL GAMES WILL BE PLAYED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HNNS PLAYING RULES, US SOCCER, CANADA SOCCER, AND FIFA LAWS OF THE GAME (LOTG).

CLUB/TEAM DUTIES AT THE HNNS YOUTH TOURNAMENT

1. TEAMS MUST HAVE ALL THEIR PLAYERS REGISTERED WITH THEIR DISTRICT/ASSOCIATION TO WHICH IT BELONGS
2. TEAM MUST HAVE APPROVAL FROM ITS DISTRICT/ASSOCIATION IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TOURNAMENT
3. TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO ARRIVE ON TIME AND BE PRESENT AT THE OPENING CEREMONIES OF THE TOURNAMENT. IF THIS REQUIREMENT IS NOT MET, CLUBS ARE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$250. EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES WILL BE DISCUSSED BY THE HNNS GOVERNING BOARD.
4. TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE NUMBERS ON ALL PLAYER JERSEYS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN A GAME.
5. WHERE 2 TEAMS' JERSEYS ARE OF SIMILAR COLOUR, THE 1ST TEAM LISTED ON THE SCHEDULE WILL BE REQUIRED TO CHANGE THEIR JERSEY. THE 1ST TEAM LISTED IS ALSO TO PROVIDE TWO (2) GAME BALLS FOR THE MATCH.
6. CLUBS/TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE PROOF OF INSURANCE FOR ALL PLAYERS WHEN PLAYING OUT OF COUNTRY/STATE/PROVINCE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT. FAILURE TO PRESENT PROOF OF INSURANCE WILL RESULT IN TEAMS NOT BEING ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH TOURNAMENT.
7. TEAMS ARE ALLOWED A MAXIMUM OF 3 GUEST PLAYERS. GUEST PLAYERS MUST HAVE PROPER RELEASE FORMS SIGNED OFF BY THEIR CLUB/DISTRICT/ASSOCIATION IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH TOURNAMENT.
8. TEAM REGISTRATION IS \$350. THIS REGISTRATION COST WILL BE DISCUSSED AS NEEDED AT THE AGM AND VOTED ON BY THE HNNS MEMBERS.
9. TEAMS MUST REGISTER A MINIMUM OF 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT WITH THE TOURNAMENT HOST AND THE REGISTRATION FEE MUST BE PAID A MINIMUM 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT.
10. TEAMS DROPPING OUT OF THE TOURNAMENT MUST NOTIFY THE HOST AT A MINIMUM OF 3 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT. TEAMS/CLUBS FAILING TO NOTIFY THE HOST MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$500. UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES WILL BE DISCUSSED BY THE HNNS GOVERNING BOARD.
11. TEAMS/CLUBS CAUGHT CHEATING WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EXPELLED FROM THE TOURNAMENT AND THEIR CLUB WILL BE FINED AND/OR PENALIZED ALSO.
12. ALL PROTESTS AND CHECKING OF PLAYER BOOKS/CARDS ARE TO BE DONE PRIOR TO THE START OF THE MATCH. TEAMS WILL HAVE UNTIL THE START OF THE 2ND HALF TO CHECK ANY BOOK/CARD OF A PLAYER THAT SHOWS UP AFTER THE INITIAL CHECK. THE REFEREE AND/OR FIELD DELEGATE IS TO BE NOTIFIED THAT THE GAME IS BEING PLAYED UNDER PROTEST. ALL PROTESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED, IN WRITING, TO THE HOST FOR FURTHER REVIEW NO LATER THAN 30 MINUTES AFTER THE FINAL WHISTLE. IN ACCORDANCE WITH FIFA LOTG, NO PROTEST ON A REFEREE'S DECISION WILL BE ENTERTAINED.
13. TEAMS THAT DO NOT HAVE THEIR PLAYER ID BOOKS/CARDS AT THE TIME OF CHECKING WILL BE GIVEN A 5-MINUTE PERIOD TO PRODUCE THEM, OTHERWISE THE TEAM WILL BE CREDITED WITH A 3-0 LOSS.

DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS FOR PLAYERS OF THE FEDERATION TOURNAMENT (Article 23)

23.1 A player who is expelled from a game due to discipline and/or foul play does not have the right to play at a determined number of games as decided by the Disciplinary Committee.

23.2 If a player gets into a fight with an opposition player from the opponents club, hits, swears, or in any way injures the dignity of a Referee, will be expelled from the Tournament.

23.3 A club shall lose all of its earned points if a club plays a player who has been suspended or penalized by the League or Federation in which the club competes.

23.4 Any player receiving either a red or yellow card shall be reported to the League or Federation in which they normally play for further disciplinary action.

23.5 The penalty for a yellow card is \$25.00 and for a red card is \$50.00. The penalized Club will be billed for all fines incurred during the tournament weekend. Fines are due before the commencement of the Annual General Meeting Any player expelled by a red card may not dress for the next game. (Approved October 28, 2006)

23.6 A Club that does not show up to a game on time will be given a 15-minute grace period. After the grace period elapses, the Club loses the game by default with a result of 1-0 in favour of the opponent. In addition, the forfeiting Club will be subject to a \$500 fine. Only in extreme situations may the fine be overturned. (Approved October 28th, 2006)
